THE KEY+ CHALLENGE

The KEY+ Challenge brings young people together in small groups and, with the support from The Key and a KEY+ Facilitator (trained deliverer), they're set the challenge to:

- 1. **Think** of a project or activity
- 2. Plan what is needed for that project including a budget
- 3. Pitch their project to a panel of volunteers
- 4. Do their project if given the go ahead by the panel
- 5. Review and reflect on their project, learning, and development
