WHAT YOU'LL DO

The KEY+ Challenge is a fun programme where small groups of young people, supported by a KEY+ Facilitator, take on the challenge of being in charge. Together you'll learn new skills whilst building confidence and having fun! You'll be set the challenge to:

1. **Think** of ideas for a fun activity or project to do together and a team name
2. **Plan** what is needed for you to do your project, starting with a £250 budget
3. **Pitch** or present your final idea to a panel of volunteers
4. **Do** your project if given the go ahead from the panel
5. **Review** and reflect on your project, learning, and development
